1 POST-DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

The National School of Public Health/Escola Nacional de Saúde Pública of the Universidade NOVA de Lisboa (ENSP/UNL) opened a competition for the attribution of 1 Post-Doctoral Fellowship, within the project “EquityCancer-LA - Improving equity in access to early diagnosis of cancer: implementation research in different healthcare systems of Latin America”, with the reference **GA – 965226_ BIPD/2022**, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Health Sciences and related areas.

Recipients: Holders of a PhD degree who cumulatively fulfil the following admission requirements:

- Competences in planning and implementation of research studies, with an emphasis on issues related to the organization of health care services;
- Experience in health services evaluation and analysis (primary and hospital health care, care integration);
- Experience in collection and analysis of quantitative and qualitative data;
- Capacity of communication and written and oral expression in Portuguese and English;
- Co-authorship of scientific publications, especially articles in indexed journals, and communications at scientific events.

Preferred factors:

- Experience in scientific research in public health issues, with a focus on issues related with organization of healthcare services;
- Experience in health services research;
- Experience in projects with multidisciplinary teams and an integrated approach;
- Capacity of organization and autonomy;
- Immediate availability.

Work plan:

- Collaboration in the project on its different components (literature review, elaboration of protocol, conceptual and methodological aspects);
- Design and coordination of the implementation of quantitative and qualitative studies for intervention evaluation;
- Design of data collection instruments, development or adaptation of methodologies, monitoring tools, evaluation and systematization of good practices;
- Design, organization and analysis of quantitative and qualitative data;
- Writing of reports, scientific articles, and other necessary documents.

Workplace and scientific orientation:

The work will be carried out at the National School of Public Health of the Universidade NOVA de Lisboa (Avenida Padre Cruz, 1600-560 Lisbon), under the scientific supervision of Professor Sónia Dias.

Duration of the fellowship:

The fellowship contract will last for 12 months, eventually renewable until the end of the project, scheduled to start in November 2022.

Amount of monthly maintenance subsidy:

The amount of the monthly subsidy is €1.686,00, amount referring to grants involving R&D activities to be carried out by PhD holders (BIPD).

To this amount is added the payment of the Personal Accident Insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection Methods:

The selection method to be used will be curriculum assessment (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, the weighting of both components will be: curriculum assessment (70%) and interview (30%).

Application deadline and form of submission of applications:

The contest is open from the **4th to the 18th of October 2022**.

Applications must be formalized by email to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt; with the **GA – 965226_BIPD/2022** in the subject, including the following documents:

1. Motivation letter;
2. Curriculum Vitae detailed of the candidate, dated and signed;
3. Documents proving that the candidate meets the conditions required for the award of the scholarship, namely a copy of the qualification certificates of all the academic degrees obtained, with a final grade;
4. For academic degrees awarded by a foreign higher education institution, it is mandatory to present the registration of the recognition of the academic degree and the conversion of the final classification to the Portuguese scale (process regulated by Decree-Law No. 341/2007, of 12 of October), or alternatively, obtaining equivalence/recognition of academic degrees (process regulated by Decree-Law no. 283/83, of 21 June); or the acceptance of enrolment in a course that confers or does not confer an academic degree.

Disclosure of Results:

The results of the evaluation will be published on the ENSP website: <https://www.ensp.unl.pt/>, up to 90 working days after the final date of application submission.

Candidates will be notified by email, within 10 working days, in the absence of any response from them, the ranking list of candidates will become definitive. From the final decision, candidates may file a complaint within 15 working days, or appeal to the highest executive body of the funding entity within 30 working days after notification of the final decision, in accordance with the provisions of article 12 of the Regulation of Foundation for Science and Technology Research Grants.
