1 Licentiate Research Fellowship

The National School of Public Health/Escola Nacional de Saúde Pública of the Universidade Nova de Lisboa (ENSP/UNL) opened a competition for the attribution of 1 Licentiate Research Fellowship, within the project “Joint action on implementation of digitally enabled integrated person-centred care – JADECARE”, with the reference: **932164/2022**, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Health Sciences and related areas.

Recipients: Licentiate degree

Admission requirements:

- § Bachelor's degree in health sciences, social sciences or related fields;
- § Knowledge and skills in the area of health promotion;
- § Skills in project planning;
- § Experience in research and/or intervention projects;
- § Ability to communicate and express oneself in written and oral form;
- § Solid knowledge of written and oral English language;
- § Ability to organize and be autonomous;
- § Enrollment in degree granting course.

Preferred factors:

- § Experience in collection and analysis of quantitative and qualitative data;
- § Immediate availability.

Work plan:

The work plan involves the development of training and research work integrated in the JADECARE project, namely:

- Support to the various components of planning and implementation of project tasks assigned to ENSP (conceptual, organizational and logistical aspects);
- Contact and liaison with partners;
- Support in the preparation and implementation of a training program;

- Support in the preparation and implementation of a co-design process, including data collection and analysis;
- Support in the writing of reports, scientific articles and other necessary documents.

Workplace and scientific orientation:

The work will be carried out at the ENSP/UNL (Avenida Padre Cruz, 1600-560 Lisbon), under the scientific supervision of Professor PhD Ana Rita Goes.

Duration of the fellowship: The fellowship contract, scheduled to start in Agosto 2022, will last for 6 months, It may be renewed until the end of the financing granted, never exceeding the maximum time defined in the EBIC.

Amount of monthly maintenance subsidy: The amount of the monthly subsidy is 875,98€ (may have a maximum value of 1.100,00€), which refers to grants that involve R&D activities to be carried out by master's students or graduates enrolled in courses that award and do not award an academic degree. In addition, to this amount, the payment of the Personal Accident Insurance and the payment of Social Security.

The amount to be paid, between the minimum and maximum stipulated above, depends on the proven experience of the candidate in the research area.

Selection Methods:

The selection method to be used will be curriculum assessment (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, the weighting of both components will be curriculum assessment (70%) and interview (30%).

President of the jury: Professor PhD Ana Rita Goes; 1st Member: Professor PhD Rui Santana; 2nd Member: Professor PhD Paulo Boto; Substitute Member: Professor PhD Andreia Leite.

Application deadline and form of submission of applications:

The contest is open from the **26th of july to the th of 8 august 2022**.

Applications must be formalized by email to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt with the **reference 932164/2022** in the subject, including the following documents:

1. Motivation letter;
2. *Curriculum Vitae*, detailed of the candidate, dated and signed;
3. Documents proving that the candidate meets the conditions required for the award of the scholarship, namely a copy of the qualification certificates of all the academic degrees obtained, with a final grade and proof of enrollment in a master's course or other non-academic degree courses;
4. For academic degrees awarded by a foreign higher education institution, it is mandatory to present the registration of the recognition of the academic degree and the conversion of the final classification to the Portuguese scale (process regulated by Decree-Law No. 341/2007, of 12 of October), or alternatively, obtaining equivalence/recognition of academic degrees (process regulated by Decree-Law no. 283/83, of 21 June); or the acceptance of enrollment in the degree-granting or non-degree-granting Course.

The results of the evaluation will be published on the ENSP website: <https://www.ensp.unl.pt/>, up to 90 working days after the final date of application submission.

Candidates will be notified by email, within 10 working days, in the absence of any response from them, the ranking list of candidates will become definitive. From the final decision, candidates may file a complaint within 15 working days, or appeal to the highest executive body of the funding entity within 30 working days after notification of the final decision, in accordance with the provisions of article 12 of the Regulation of FCT, I.P. Research Grants.
