1. Title of the abstract

2. Introduction

Problem description and most pertinent available knowledge

Objectives of the study and its clinical importance

3. Methods

Describe the experimental design, the analytical techniques and statistics used in the study

4. Results

Should contain the data that answers the scientific question/problem. Must be shown the associations between interventions and outcomes.

5. Conclusions

Conclusion of the study directly supported by the results you've achieved and its associations with other study's made in this context.

6. References (Not mandatory)

Should be used the Vancouver style.

7. Poster Topic (see the list below)

Any kind of advertisements to companies/products etc will not be allowed

- Abstracts should be written in clear and concise English

- Abbreviations should be defined

Maximum size: 300 words
