Research Fellowship *Master*

The NOVA National School of Public Health, Universidade NOVA de Lisboa, has opened an offer position for 1 Research Fellowship, within the scope of the project “ELEVATE - Early detection of cervical cancer in hard-to-reach populations of women through portable and point-of-care HPV testing”, (SEP-210511221), funded by the European Commission, Call H2020-SC1-BHC-2018-2020, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Public Health

Requirements:

- a) Experience in scientific research on public health issues, with an emphasis on vulnerable populations;
- b) Competencies in the area of monitoring and evaluation of health interventions;
- c) Experience in quantitative and qualitative data collection and analysis;
- d) Ability to communicate and express, written and orally, in Portuguese and English;
- e) immediate availability.

Preferential factors:

- a) Team organization and management skills;
- b) Co-authorship of scientific publications, especially articles in indexed journals, and communications at scientific events;
- c) Capacity of organization and autonomy.

Work plan:

The research fellow will develop his/her work within the scope of an ongoing research project that involves the implementation of an acceptability study of an intervention in the field of cervical cancer screening promotion in vulnerable populations. The work plan includes the following activities:

- i. Operational preparation of the study in its different components (methodological, organizational and logistical aspects);
- ii. Mobilization, involvement and articulation with community partners;
- iii. Support in the organisation, coordination and implementation of the field work;
- iv. vi) Organization and monitoring of data collection (e.g. questionnaire surveys; focus groups);



- v. Analysis of quantitative and qualitative data;
- vi. Writing of reports, scientific articles and other necessary documents.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, Universidade NOVA de Lisboa, under the scientific supervision of Professor Sónia Dias.

Duration of the Research Fellowship: The duration of the research fellowship will be for 12 months, starting in December of 2022. The fellowship contract can be renewed until the end of the project.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 1 144,64€, (it may reach a maximum value of 1 686,00€, according to proven technical and scientific skills) according to the values for research fellowships awarded by FCT, IP in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Application deadline: The call is open from **15 until 29 of November 2022**.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail addressed to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference **ELEVATE_BI-M-1_2022** in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: *Curriculum Vitae*, motivation letter and academic degree certificate.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline for application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase: proof of academic degrees and the respective recognitions when they have been awarded by foreign higher education institutions (for more information please go to <https://www.dges.gov.pt/>) and proof of enrolment in a course that does not lead to the attainment of an academic degree.
