Master Research Fellowship

The NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, has opened an offer position for 1 Research Fellowship, within the scope of the R&D project Academy for Patient Associations Capacity Building (ACAD), funded by Roche, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Communication Sciences

Requirements:

- a) Master's degree in the area of communication sciences;
- b) Experience in projects in the area of public health;
- c) Experience in projects with patient associations;
- d) Experience in communication management;
- e) Communication and written expression skills;
- f) Attend a course that confers or does not confer an academic degree.

Preferential factors (optional):

- a) Experience in planning and executing communication on digital channels;
- b) Experience in project management;
- c) Experience in analyzing communication metrics and project execution;
- d) Immediate availability;
- e) Ability to adapt to different tasks;
- f) Spirit of initiative and ability to work as a team;
- g) Organization and autonomy skills.

Work plan: The successful applicant will participate in the planning, execution and evaluation of the activities planned for the Academy for Capacity Building of Patients' Associations, namely: planning and organizing events; planning and implementation of ACAD's strategic communication, in its different channels; creating communication content; management of communication with patient associations and other partners; monitoring ACAD activities. He/she will also support project management.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor Ana Rita Goes.

Duration of the Research Fellowship(s): the duration of the research fellowship(s) will be for 6 months, starting in March of 2024. The research fellowship can be renewed until the maximum of 12 months.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 1.199,64 €, (up to 1.350,00€ according to technical and scientific skills), according to the values for research fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Composition of the selection Jury: President: Ana Rita Goes, 1st Member: Ana Rita Pedro, 2nd Member: Ana Gama.

Application deadline: The call is open from 01/02/2024 until 15/02/2024.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference 951082_241 in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter and academic degree certificate.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

- a) proof of academic degrees and the respective recognitions when they have been awarded by foreign higher education institutions (for more information please go to <https://www.dges.gov.pt/>);
- b) proof of enrolment in a master's degree, PhD or in a course that does not lead to attainment an academic degree.
