

## RESEARCH GRANT

### Bachelor Research Fellowship

The NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, has opened an offer position for 1 Research Fellowships(s), within the scope of the R&D project, PTDC/SAU-SER/7406/2020, funded by Foundation for Science and Technology (Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, FCT) through R&D Projects in All Scientific Domains (2020), under the following conditions:

**Scientific area:** Health sciences – Health and healthcare services

**Requirements:**

- Master's degree in economics or in life and health sciences.
- Enrolled in an academic or non-academic degree-granting course.
- Experience in data analysis and statistics, demonstrated by a curriculum vitae.
- Ability to communicate in written and oral Portuguese and English.
- Availability to start activities from September.

**Preferential factors:**

- Ability to work in teams, and interest in Health Economics issues.
- Experience in scientific literature review and the use of bibliographic management tools.
- Skills in summarizing information and presenting it in a clear and concise manner, both in spoken and written form.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office applications, as well as ease in using video conferencing tools like Zoom and Skype.

**Work plan:**

- The fellow will be integrated into a multidisciplinary team with academic and scientific experience.
- The fellow will be responsible for gathering information from scientific literature, as well as analyzing collected data.
- Additionally, the fellow will provide support in processes and procedures related to contact with various stakeholders involved in the project.
- The fellow will assist in preparing funding application submissions.

**Workplace and scientific supervision:** The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Researcher Joana Alves and Professor Julian Perelman.

**Duration of the Research Fellowship(s):** the duration of the research fellowship(s) will be for three months, starting in October of 2023. The research fellowship can be renewed until the end of the funding granted, never exceeding the maximum time defined in the EBIC.

**Monthly maintenance allowance:** The amount of the fellowship is 1259,64 €, according to the values for research fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

**Selection methods:** The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

**Composition of the selection Jury:** President: Joana Alves, 1st Member: Julian Perelman, 2nd Member: Pedro Aguiar.

**Application deadline:** The call is open from 06/05/2024 until 20/05/2024.

**Application formalization:** Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to [gaidi@ensp.unl.pt](mailto:gaidi@ensp.unl.pt), with the reference 932183\_241 in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter, academic degree certificate and sworn statement that the applicant does not exceed, with the conclusion of the fellowship, an accumulated period of two years, consecutive or interpolated, in this type of fellowship.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

- a) Copy of civil and tax identification document(s) and, where applicable, social security document(s);
- b) Document proving the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, where applicable, valid at the start date of the fellowship;
- c) Documents proving that the candidate meets the conditions required for the respective type of fellowship, namely proof of enrollment and registration in a cycle of studies or non-degree course and/or proof of academic qualifications required for the type of fellowship, if applicable.
