Bachelor Research Fellowship

The National School of Public Health/Escola Nacional de Saúde Pública of the Universidade Nova de Lisboa (ENSP/UNL) opened a competition for the attribution of 1 Bachelor Research Fellowship, within the project “Avaliação das principais preocupações da pessoa com doença renal crónica na gestão da doença, impactos na vida do dia-a-dia, principais constrangimentos no acesso aos cuidados de saúde – CONCORDIA DRC”, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Health Sciences and related areas.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in health sciences;
- Knowledge in the area of health management;
- Skills in project planning;
- Experience in research projects;
- Ability to communicate and express oneself in written and oral form;
- Solid knowledge of written and oral English language;
- Ability to organize and be autonomous;
- Enrollment in degree granting course.

Preferential factors:

- Experience in collection and analysis of quantitative and qualitative data;
- Experience in Consensus Techniques, namely Delphi Panel;
- Immediate availability.

Work plan: The work plan involves the development of training and research work integrated in the CONCORDIA DRC project, namely:

- Support to the various components of planning and implementation of project tasks assigned to ENSP (conceptual, organizational and logistical aspects);
- Contact and liaison with partners;
- Implementation of a Consensus Technique;
- Support in the preparation and organization of a Conference;
- Support in the writing of reports, scientific articles and other necessary documents.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor PhD Ana Rita Pedro.

Duration of the Research Fellowship(s): the duration of the research fellowship(s) will be for 12 months, starting in September 2024. The research fellowship(s) can be renewed up to the maximum provided for in the Research Fellowship Regulations of NOVA University Lisbon.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 990.98 € (may have a higher value, according to the technical and scientific skills demonstrated), according to the values for research fellowships awarded by NOVA in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Composition of the selection Jury: PhD Ana Rita Pedro; 1st Member: Professor PhD João Valente Cordeiro; 2nd Member: PhD Ana Gama; Substitute Member: Professor PhD Ana Rita Goes.

Application deadline: The call is open from 22/07/2024 a 05/08/2024.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference 951051_241 in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter and academic degree certificate.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

- a) Copy of civil and tax identification document(s) and, where applicable, social security document(s);
- b) Document proving the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, where applicable, valid at the start date of the fellowship;
- c) Documents proving that the candidate meets the conditions required for the respective type of fellowship, namely proof of enrollment and registration in a cycle of studies or non-degree course and/or proof of academic qualifications required for the type of fellowship, if applicable.
