Master Research Fellowship

The NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, has opened an offer position for 1 Research Fellowships(s), within the scope of the R&D project *Advancing Prevention Research In Cancer through Ontology Tools (The APRICOT project)*, funded by the National Institutes of Health - USA, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Behavioural Sciences, Health Promotion, Health Psychology

Requirements:

- a) MSc in Health Psychology, Health Promotion or Behavioural Sciences;
- b) Solid knowledge of theories, frameworks in Behavioral Sciences applied to health;
- c) Knowledge of ontologies/classification systems of behaviour change interventions;
- d) Strong written and oral English language skills;
- e) Organizational and autonomy skills;
- f) Enrollment in a course leading to or not leading to an academic degree.

Work plan:

- a) Scientific Development of ontologies of behaviour change interventions and behaviors;
- b) Support in the development of tools for ontology search, visualization and for intervention design;
- c) Development and management of the APRICOT Community of Practice;
- d) Support to APRICOT project management activities.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor Marta Moreira Marques

Duration of the Research Fellowship(s): the duration of the research fellowship(s) will be for 9 months, starting in November 2024. The research fellowship(s) can be renewed up to a maximum of 24 months.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 1259,64 €, according to the values for research fellowships awarded by NOVA in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Composition of the selection Jury: President: Marta Moreira Marques, 1st Member: Cristina Godinho, 2nd Member: Ana Gama.

Application deadline: The call is open from 14/10/2024 until 28/10/2024.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference 932219_241 in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, and academic degree certificate.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

- a) Copy of civil and tax identification document(s) and, where applicable, social security document(s);
- b) Document proving the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, where applicable, valid at the start date of the fellowship;
- c) Documents proving that the candidate meets the conditions required for the respective type of fellowship, namely proof of enrollment and registration in a cycle of studies or non-degree course and/or proof of academic qualifications required for the type of fellowship, if applicable.
