Postdoctoral Research Fellowship

The NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, has opened an offer position for 1 Postdoctoral Research Fellowship(s), within the scope of research of Partnerships for Science Education, 932188_241, funded by own funds, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Health Sciences

Requirements:

- a) Doctorate degree;
- b) Solid knowledge of written and oral English language;
- c) Immediate availability;
- d) Experience in science education projects;
- f) Publications in indexed international journals (minimum: 3)

Preferential factors (optional): doesn't apply.

Work plan:

- Present and publish research results in scientific meetings and publications.
- Participate in outreach communication activities and events for non-specialist audiences.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor Carolina Santos.

Duration of the Research Fellowship(s): the duration of the research fellowship(s) will be for 3 months, starting in December of 2024. The research fellowship(s) can be renewed until the end of the funding granted, never exceeding the maximum time defined in the Statute of Scientific Research Fellow.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 1801,00€, according to the values for research fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Composition of the selection Jury: President: Carolina Santos, 1st Member: Paulo Sousa, 2nd Member: Ana Gama.

Application deadline: The call is open from 15/11/2024 until 29/11/2024.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference 932188_241 in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter, academic degree certificate and a sworn statement that, with the signing of this fellowship, it does not exceed an accumulated period of three years in this sort of contract, consecutive or interpolated, in the Portuguese scientific and technological system and the academic work leading to the doctoral degree was carried out in a host entity different from the entity where the research work will be carried out.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

a) proof of academic degrees and the respective recognitions when they have been awarded by foreign higher education institutions (for more information please go to <https://www.dges.gov.pt/>);
