

RESEARCH GRANT

Master Research Fellowship

The NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, has opened an offer position for 1 Research Fellowships, within the scope of the R&D project "LOCUS: LOng Covid – Understanding Symptoms, events and use of services in Portugal", 932190_241, funded by Pfizer, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Health and social sciences or similar

Requirements:

- a) Advanced training in public health;
- b) Previous experience in research projects in the public health area;
- c) Excellent command of written and oral English;
- d) Communication and written expression skills;
- e) Attend a course that confers or does not confer an academic degree.

Preferential factors (optional):

- a) Experience in the presentation and publication of scientific research projects results (manuscripts and oral presentations);
- b) Experience in quantitative data analysis using statistical software (SPSS, R or other);
- c) Experience in post-COVID condition epidemiology research;
- d) Immediate availability;
- e) Capacity to adapt to diverse tasks;
- f) Organization and autonomy skills.

Work plan:

- a) Literature review;
- b) Data analysis;
- c) Editorial products preparation.

Applicable Legislation and Regulations: <u>Statute of Scientific Research Fellow</u>, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, amended and published by Decree-Law nr. 202/2012, of August 27, amended by Decree-Law nr. 233/2012, of October 29, by Law nr. 12/2013, of January 29, by Decree-Law nr. 89/2013 of July 9 and by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28 and the rules established in the Research Fellow Regulations of NOVA University Lisbon.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor Andreia Leite.

Duration of the Research Fellowship: the duration of the research fellowship will be for 3 months, starting in February of 2025. The research fellowship can be renewed up to the maximum of 3 months.



Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 1259.64€ (may have a higher value, according to the technical and scientific skills demonstrated), according to the values for research fellowships awarded by NOVA in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Composition of the selection Jury: President: Andreia Leite, 1st Member: Ana Rita Goes, 2nd Member: Joana Alves, Substitute member: Sílvia Lopes.

Application deadline: The call is open from 16th January 2025 until 30th January 2025.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference 932190_241, in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter and academic degree certificate.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

a) Copy of civil and tax identification document(s) and, where applicable, social security document(s);

b) Document proving the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, where applicable, valid at the start date of the fellowship;

c) Documents proving that the candidate meets the conditions required for the respective type of fellowship, namely proof of enrollment and registration in a cycle of studies or non-degree course and/or proof of academic qualifications required for the type of fellowship, if applicable.
