The NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, has opened an offer position for 1 Research Fellowships, within the scope of the R&D project Desempenho Ambiental das Instituições de Cuidados de Saúde Portuguesas: indicadores, metas e intervenções- AmbiSaúde, with the reference 2023.15731.PEX, funded by FCT, IP, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Health and/or Environmental Sciences

Requirements:

- a) Graduation in health and/or Environmental Sciences;
- b) Competencies on quantitative methods;
- c) Capacity for oral and written communication;
- d) Solid knowledge on English language (spoken and written);
- e) Autonomy and organizational skills;
- f) Frequency of course (with or without degree).

Preferential factors (optional):

- a) Previous participation on projects related with Public Health;
- b) Experience in data collection and analysis;
- c) Immediate availability.

Work plan:

- Bibliographic reviews on the topics of the project;
- Collection, management and analysis of datasets;
- Write reports, scientific papers and other documents needed;
- Support of project management activities.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor Susana Viegas

Duration of the Research Fellowship(s): the duration of the research fellowship(s) will be for 6 months, starting in March of 2025. The research fellowship can be renewed up to the maximum provided for in the Research Fellowship Regulations of Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I. P.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 1 040,98 €, according to the values for research fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Composition of the selection Jury: President: Susana Viegas, 1st Member: José Chen, 2nd Member: Silvia Lopes.

Application deadline: The call is open from 17/02/2025 until 03/03/2025.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference 932226_251 in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter and academic degree certificate.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

- a) Copy of civil, tax and, when applicable, social security identification document(s);
- b) Document proving the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, when applicable, valid at the start date of the fellowship;
- c) Documents proving that you meet the conditions required for the respective type of fellowship, namely proof of enrollment and enrollment in a study cycle or course that does not award an academic degree and proof of ownership of academic qualifications;
