Bachelor Research Fellowship

The NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, has opened an offer position for 1 Research Fellowships(s), within the scope of the R&D project: Desempenho Ambiental das Instituições de Cuidados de Saúde Portuguesas: indicadores, metas e intervenções- AmbiSaúde, 2023.15731.PEX, funded by FCT, IP, under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Social Sciences

Requirements:

- a) Undergraduate degree in behavioral sciences, social sciences, or health sciences;
- b) Skills in quantitative and qualitative methodologies;
- c) Strong communication and written/oral expression skills;
- d) Proficiency in written and spoken English;
- e) Organizational skills and ability to work independently;
- f) Enrollment in a cycle of studies or non-degree course.

Preferential factors (optional):

- a) Knowledge of behavioral change models;
- b) Participation in research projects, preferably in the field of public health;
- c) Immediate availability.

Work plan:

- a) Conduct literature review related to the project's theme;
- b) Develop a behavioral science–informed online survey to assess barriers and facilitators in healthcare settings;
- c) Build and maintain a database and analyze data resulting from the survey;
- d) Conduct interviews with healthcare stakeholders and support qualitative data analysis;
- e) Draft reports, scientific articles, and other necessary documents;
- f) Provide project management support and collaborate with other team members.

Workplace and scientific supervision: The work will be carried out at NOVA National School of Public Health, NOVA University Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Professor Susana Viegas.

Duration of the Research Fellowship(s): the duration of the research fellowship(s) will be for 6 months, starting in November of 2025. The research fellowship(s) can be renewed up to the maximum provided for in the Research Fellowship Regulamento de Bolsas de Investigação da FCT, I. P

Monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the fellowship is 1 040,98€ €, according to the values for research fellowships awarded by FCT in Portugal. In addition to this amount, there is the payment of personal accident insurance and the payment of voluntary social security.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (100%) in case there is no need for an interview. If an interview is considered necessary, both components will be weighted: Curriculum evaluation (70%) and interview (30%).

Composition of the selection Jury: President: Susana Viegas, 1st Member: Julian Perelman, 2nd Member: Marta Marques.

Application deadline: The call is open from September 24, 2025 until October 14, 2025.

Application formalization: Applications must be formalized mandatorily by e-mail to gaidi@ensp.unl.pt, with the reference 932226_252 in the subject, and must include mandatorily the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, motivation letter and academic degree certificate.

The documents required for the submission of the application will only be admitted if submitted within the deadline of application.

The following documents will be requested in the contracting phase:

- a) Copy of civil and tax identification document(s) and, where applicable, social security document(s);
- b) Document proving the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, where applicable, valid at the start date of the fellowship;
- c) Documents proving that the candidate meets the conditions required for the respective type of fellowship, namely proof of enrollment and registration in a cycle of studies or non-degree course and/or proof of academic qualifications required for the type of fellowship, if applicable.
